

**EAST WINDSOR BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL MEETING/EXECUTIVE SESSION MINUTES
August 6, 2021
East Windsor High School Library
76 South Main Street, East Windsor, CT**

The meeting was called to order by Chair R. Reichle at 5:34 p.m.

In attendance: Chair R. Reichle, Vice Chair H. Spencer, Secretary K. Carey-Trull, S. Andrews, F. Neill, D. Swaim. Member W. Raber joined the session by phone.

Assistant Superintendent Dr. P. Tudryn was in attendance for an interview as well.

On a motion by F. Neill, 2nd by S. Andrews, the Board entered into executive session to discuss the appointment, employment, performance, evaluation, dismissal or the health of a public officer or employee, provided that such individual may require that the discussion be held at an open meeting: Superintendent interview internal candidate and possible superintendent contract negotiations.

Discussion of topic at hand ensued.

The Board came out of executive session at 6:45 p.m.

A motion was made by W. Raber, 2nd by H. Spencer, to nominate Dr. P. Tudryn to be superintendent of the East Windsor School District.

K. Carey-Trull asked if an interim could be named for a month or two while public input was gathered before making a final decision. Chair R. Reichle said the position would have to be posted, an interim superintendent couldn't be named without a search process beginning.

The vote was as follows, W. Raber – yes, H. Spencer – yes, F. Neill – yes, D. Swaim – abstained, K. Carey-Trull – No (She said more time for discussion and to gather public input was warranted before making such an important decision for the district), R. Reichle – yes. The vote was as follows: 4-1-1 (4 yes, 1 no, 1 abstention).

On a motion by F. Neill, 2nd by H. Spencer, the Board voted to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 p.m. The vote was as follows: W. Raber – yes, H. Spencer – yes, F. Neill – yes, D. Swaim – yes, K. Carey-Trull – yes, R. Reichle, yes.
