Career and Vocational Education

Agricultural Science and Technology Education

The Board of Education, in the absence of a district agricultural science and technology education program, as defined by statute, shall designate a school or schools approved by the State Board of Education as the school to which any student residing in the district may attend upon successful completion of the eighth grade. The district shall pay the tuition and any reasonable and necessary transportation costs of any student under twenty-one years of age who is not a graduate of a high school or vocational school who attends the designated school.

The designated school offering a program in agricultural science and technology education for district students to attend is Vernon Regional Agricultural Science and Technology program, Vernon, CT.

Students in East Windsor Public Schools may apply to and, if accepted, attend other agricultural science and technology education programs at a cost to the East Windsor Public Schools but only at a tuition rate that is less than or equal to the cost for attendance at the Vernon Regional Agricultural Science and Technology program.

Transportation will be provided only to the designated school. One exception will be for the transportation of students attending the Suffield Regional Agriscience program through June 2021. Following June 2021, the East Windsor Public Schools will only provide transportation to the designated program.
