Health Requirements for School Entrance

Immunizations

Any student registering with the East Windsor Public schools must provide copies of all immunizations. Copies of immunizations must be easily read and verified by an authorized licensed medical professional. Should any immunization series be incomplete, you will be notified to obtain this vaccination for your child. All pre-k students must have their influenza vaccine before January 1 of the year your child enters school so for this year by January 3, 2022. Your child will not be allowed to attend school without completed immunization requirements.

It is your right to refuse immunizations for medical or religious reasons. If you decline immunizations for medical reasons your physician must complete the required state form. If the refusal is religious, new state law requires parents to complete the state exemption form with completed signatures from the noted professionals on the form. School nurses **will not** sign for religious exemptions in the East Windsor Public Schools.

Health Assessments

Student entering our district in grades kindergarten, 6 and 10 must have a physical exam and oral exam completed within the last year prior to entrance into school. These exams should be completed by the pediatrician on the Connecticut State Health K-12 Assessment form. The front page of the health assessment form **must** be completed by a parent. Your pediatrician will complete **page 2** of this form after the physical exam. The risk for tuberculosis must be completed on the form. Your dentist or dental hygienist will complete page 3. Students entering in all other grades must present their most updated health assessment record. A copy of the health assessment record is available on our school website @ www.eastwindsork12.org. Click the parent resources link on the website and follow the link to the health office or central registration.

All out of state students entering Connecticut schools are mandated by state law to have an updated completed physical and oral health assessment. This exam must have been completed within the last 12 months and should be completed on the Connecticut State blue health assessment form. The risk for tuberculosis assessment must be completed on the form.

Student entering Connecticut schools from outside the United States are required to have a physical exam completed by a provider licensed to practice in the United States. Tuberculosis testing is a required part of this exam.

All medical information must be provided to the school by the parent. It is not the responsibility of the school nurse or the school to obtain this information from the child's previous school for the parent when registering their child.

Our School Based Health Center located at East Windsor High School is available for completion of physical exams and immunizations by appointment. The health center is open on Monday through Friday. Parents can call 860-623-3361 ext. 7247 to schedule an appointment. Students must be enrolled in CHC to access these services. Enrollment forms can be completed at the time of your visit, they are also available online at our school website.
