Dear Parents and Guardians:

As you are aware, on Tuesday, March 10, 2020 the Governor declared a Public Health and Civil Preparedness Emergency in the state of Connecticut as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic. As school districts across the state prepare for possible school closings, we want to send you information regarding our plan for the attendance and transportation of students in placements outside of the East Windsor Public Schools District.

Please note our plan and procedures during the time of school closures for East Windsor Public Schools (EWPS):

- Students attending out of district placements will not be transported to school by EWPS;
- Please contact your child's school directly to determine if they are open and are allowing students from closed districts to attend;
- If your child's school is open, and your child can attend, it would be your responsibility to transport him/her to school;
- In the event that your child's school also closes, they may be providing your child with alternative learning plans, packet, etc...
- Upon EWPS schools reopening, EWPS will resume transporting students who attend out of district placements
- Parent Placement Team (PPT) meetings may need to be rescheduled during the time the District is closed, and these PPT meetings will be rescheduled in a timely manner once schools reopen.

The underlying purpose of these procedures is to follow the guidance of state and local officials to take the necessary steps to protect public health and safety. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. It is our hope that your family remains healthy! Thank you for your continued support and collaboration.
