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PRE-KINDERGARTEN APPLICATION PROCESS

The East Windsor Public Schools will begin accepting applications for the 2019-2020 Integrated Prekindergarten classes. The East Windsor Public Schools Integrated Prekindergarten program is offered five days per week for half-day sessions. Integrated Prekindergarten classes serve the needs of students with disabilities, as well as nondisabled peers.

To be considered for the lottery process to the Prekindergarten program this September, please complete the application available online at www.eastwindsork12.org, at Broad Brook Elementary School, or at the Board of Education Office and return it by Thursday, March 21, 2019 to:

For the 2019-2020 academic year, we will be offering preschool slots to those families whose children are already on our preschool waiting list. Once we have received notice regarding the number of slots filled through the waiting list, we will then fill remaining available slots by lottery on March 25, 2019. A wait list according to lottery number will be kept for students who are not selected, as well as children who apply following the lottery. Parents will be notified of placements or inclusion on the wait list the week following the lottery. Information regarding preschool screenings will be included with the placement notification.

To be eligible for registration, students must be at least 3 years of age by August 31, 2019, or 4 years of age by December 31, 2019, residents of East Windsor, and complete the full registration packet, including immunization information, at the time of registration.

There is a fee to attend this program. The cost is \$100 per month or \$1000 for the full year. The fee is pro-rated for children who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program.
