Minutes May 21, 2025:

- Minutes from the May 21, 2025 subcommittee meeting were approved.

Discussion:

1. FMLA Policy - Recommended updates and revisions
 - a. Subcommittee members reviewed the recommended revisions by Shipman & Goodwin due to recent changes in CT state legislation. The subcommittee recommended accepting the changes and forwarding them to the full School Board for a first reading.
2. AI Policy
 - a. Subcommittee members reviewed the draft policy that was presented and engaged in a discussion regarding the need to develop accompanying regulations for both staff and students to ensure effective implementation of the policy. It was agreed that draft regulations will be prepared and presented to the subcommittee by Spring 2026 for further review. Recommendation was made to have AI free at the elementary level for students.
3. Cell Phone Policy
 - a. Discussion ensued regarding the Board recommendations for possible changes to the district's cell phone procedures. It will be placed on the next agenda for further discussion.

Miscellaneous:

- Dr. Tudryn reported that recent changes in Connecticut legislation now require local Boards of Education to adopt policies pertaining to school libraries. He noted that model draft policies have not yet been released and will be reviewed and added to a future agenda once they become available.
