I. CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER

D. Rouillard called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM.

III. MINUTES

On a motion by C. Sevarino, second by N. Farmer, to approve the March 13, 2026 special meeting minutes. PASSED with a unanimous vote.

IV. DISCUSSION

1) Discussion ensued regarding a recap of spring sports.

- Baseball - currently has five East Windsor students and is a co-op with Computer Science. East Windsor is the host team and will continue to co-op with Computer Science next year. 2027 participation: two returning East Windsor students with the possibility of seven or eight grade 8 students. Baseball made the Class M state tournament this year.
- Softball - currently 13 East Windsor students. Four are graduating, one is coming from grade 8. Program is looking for a co-op for next school year.
- Golf - one East Windsor student
- Outdoor track - 53 at EWHS students, 28 made the NCCC tournament, nine made class S state tournament.
- EWMS track - Discussion ensued regarding the spring season. The school was able to participate in three track meets.

2) Discussion ensued regarding anticipated co-op participation for the 2026-2027 school year.

- Football with Windsor Locks - Windsor Locks is the host school - potentially four East Windsor students
- Girls Soccer with Windsor Locks - Windsor Locks is the host school - possibly five East Windsor students
- Girls Basketball - potential co-op with East Granby - East Granby would be the host school, but East Windsor will have two home games played at EWHS - possibly five East Windsor students
- Baseball with Computer Science - East Windsor is host school (see above)
- Softball - see above
- Wrestling - team of one with South Windsor. If other students wanted to wrestle there would be the opportunity available.

- Gymnastics - team of 1 with South Windsor
- 3) Discussion ensued regarding additional participation in 2026-2027 sports
 - Discussed if it would be beneficial to offer volleyball at the middle school. D. Edwards will look into it.
